August 14, 2010 – Firemen’s Day – Parade starts at the Omni-Centre at 12:15 pm and ends at Bellevue Park at 1:30 pm - The Pincourt Volunteer Firemen’s Association invites you to this very special edition of this classic municipal event. Featuring : Arthur L’Aventurier, Andrée Watters, Sylvain Cossette. Of course, their famous fireworks display will once again amaze you!

August 21, 2010 – Boating Day – Bellevue Park from 10:00am to 4:00 pm – Come and discover your newly redesigned park by taking part in the free use of canoes, kayaks and rabaskas in Bellevue Bay. Appropriate safety measures will be in place.
